Chester is a walled city in Cheshire, England, on the River Dee, close to the border with Wales.

Once England's largest Roman fortification, Chester still bears evidence of that ancient heritage today. On this one-of-a-kind walking tour, discover the city's most important Roman-era landmarks, and explore in the company of a costumed gladiator. Pick between two daily tour times, and set off on foot. You'll discover the Chester Roman Amphitheatre, the Chester Roman Gardens, will stroll its city walls, and will learn entertaining stories about its history as you go

Accommodation: STONE VILLA
