Almost undamaged by WW2, Prague's medieval centre remains a wonderful mixture of cobbled lanes, walled courtyards, cathedrals and countless churches, all in the shadow of the majestic 9th Castle. The Prague Christmas markets are open daily at the Old Town Square and Wenceslas Square. A 'winter wonderland' awaits, for visitors to soak up the festive atmosphere, browse the stalls, and enjoy Christmas carols, hearty food and local drinks.

Christmas markets (Vanocni trh) are a key ingredient of the festive magic in the Czech Republic, and the Prague Christmas markets are the most impressive. The markets light up the city, bringing locals and tourists together in a true 'winter wonderland' setting. The main markets are at the Old Town Square and Wenceslas Square (5 minutes walk from each other).

Plus there are smaller markets at Republic Square, at Havel's Market, on Kampa Island, and on the square in front of St. George's Basilica at Prague Castle.

The markets consist of brightly decorated wooden huts selling traditional handicrafts: glassware, jewellery, embroidered lace, wooden toys, metalware, ceramics, scented candles, Christmas tree ornaments, hats, gloves and scarves, and puppets and dolls beautifully dressed in traditional costumes.

Visitors should find some nice items to take home, to decorate their houses or to use as Christmas gifts.

But Christmas markets are not just about shopping. Visitors can observe traditional foods being made, and sample all manner of local produce. Large hams are roasted on spits, there are terribly unhealthy but wonderfully tasty barbecued sausages (klobása), and cakes and pastries prepared in front of you, such as 'Trdelník', a hot sugar coated pastry.

Our Accommodation is Betlem Club Hotel

Set in a UNESCO-protected mediaeval building in Prague's Old Town, Betlem Club Hotel is a 5-minute walk from Charles Bridge and the Old Town Square. Free Wi-Fi is available in the entire hotel.

Guests can start their day with a buffet breakfast including hot dishes every morning. Hotel Betlem's rooms come with a fridge, satellite TV and a private bathroom with shower or bathtub. Most of the rooms have dark wooden beams and wooden furniture.
